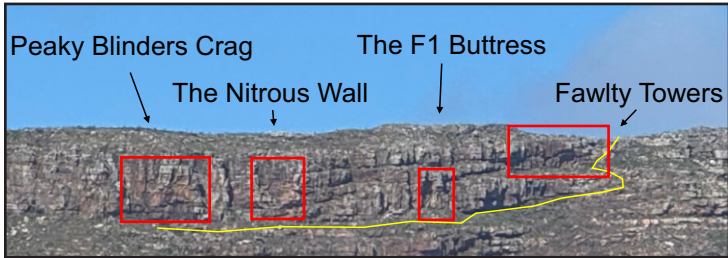


The Lower Fawlty Crags



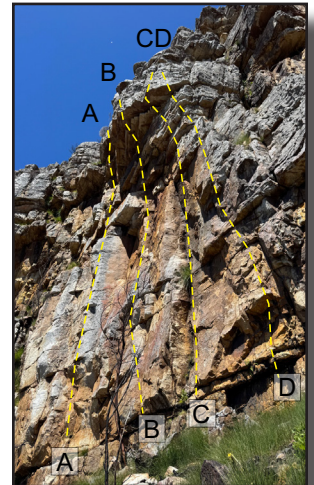
Lower Fawlty Towers has three newly developed crags. The routes are long and climb interesting features created by the bizarre weathering of the rock as it is somewhat soft in places. A number of projects are still in progress.

Climb carefully as these are all new routes and in spite of cleaning small foot and hand holds may still break over the next few ascents - until the routes settle in. Belay to the side and consider a helmet for your belayer.

Approach as for Fawlty Towers but then head down leftwards to the lower tier - via a number of stainless steel staples to assist you with your descent.

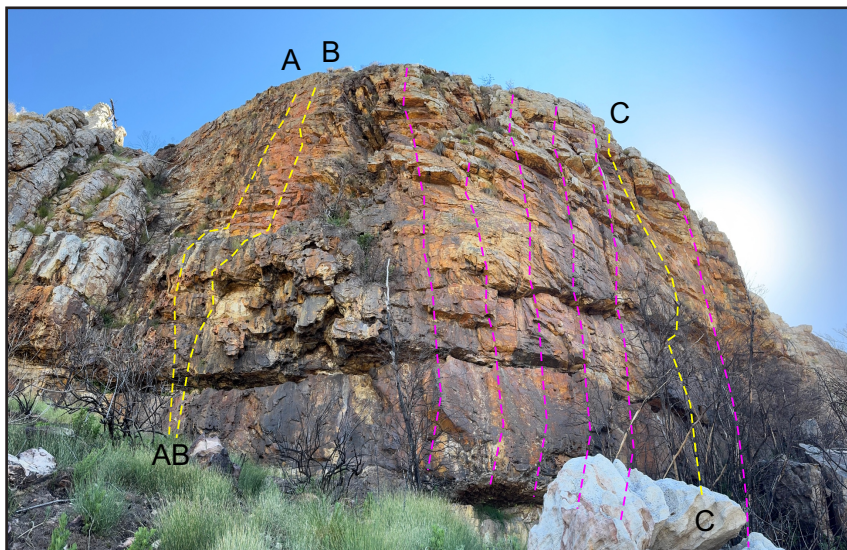
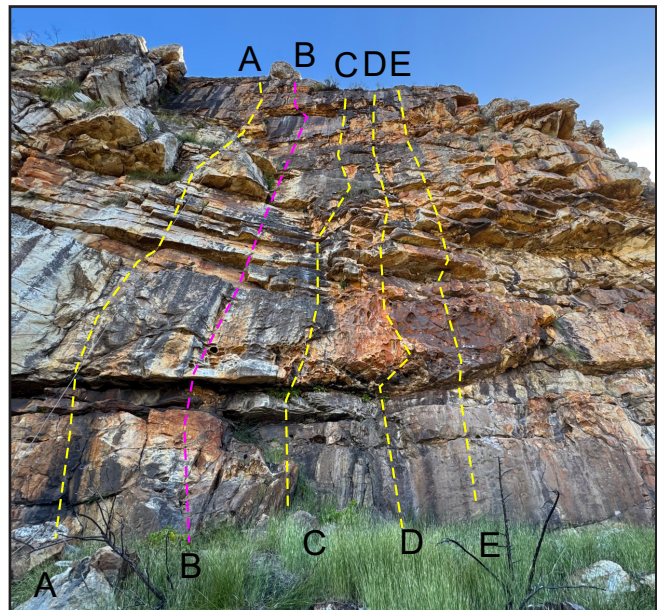
